

Level 3 - Quick Lesson 3 – Another Future / Pronunciation.

Know -> You say this when you already have a relationship (closer or distant) with someone or something.

When you want to say “Eu conheci alguém”, you **CAN'T** use “know”, you have to use “meet” (in this case – met – the past of meet) – “I met somebody”.

Meet -> When you don't know something/somebody and they don't know you and they encounter each one.

!! Know ≠ Meet !!

→ Future ←

“ I'm doing this project next Saturday. Could you come and help me? “

** When you say “I'm doing...” means that you are doing something right now (Present)

BUT, It can also mean that you'll do something (Future) **

→ Future

1st way: I'm going to do something...

2nd way: I'll do something...

3rd way: I'm doing something ...

New Word: Wobble = tremer, balançar

Wobbly = trêmulo

Ex: “Hi! My friend Nathan is walking Five miles for a Charity.

Would you like to contribute?”.

Charity = To give Money to the poor. Save money for an institution, etc. (Obras de Caridade)

** It can mean that he's walking right now but probably means that he'll walk. **

-> How to recognize each one <-

1st -> By the context.

2nd -> By mentioning the time (when It will happen)

Ex: I'm doing this **tomorrow night**. (tomorrow - future)

→ Pronunciation ←

-> For most longer words, in English, the strongest part is pronounced at the beginning.

Ex: - Contribute. /*can-trí-biu-t/*

** Most time the strongest syllable is the first or the second one. **

- Important /*im-pór-tent/*
- Development /*devé-lop-ment/*
- Improvement /*im-pruuv-ment/*
- Comedy /*có-me-dy/*
- Probably /*pró-ba-bly/*
